





Help is Here

Help is available to anyone struggling to pay their energy bills as a result of COVID-19, whether because of contracting the virus, caring for someone with the virus, or through a lost job.

Follow these four steps if you are struggling to pay your energy bill.

- **1.** Contact your energy provider or propane supplier for flexible payment options, energy saving tools, resources, or available programs.
- **2.** Call 2-1-1 or go to mi211.org for help paying your energy bill.
- **3.** Apply for State Emergency Relief (SER) directly for bill payment assistance at michigan.gov/mibridges.
 - Need help with this? Call 2-1-1 to be referred to a Michigan Energy Assistance Program (MEAP) grantee that can help.
- **4.** Apply for a Home Heating Credit. Visit michigan.gov/treasury to see if you qualify.

Remember, if you need help, the first step is to contact your energy provider.
