MISchoolData is set up in a very “nested” format. When you arrive, you will notice there are large blue dropdown menus across the top that open up to the nested reports when you hover over a selection. Once a report is opened, other reports in the same category can be accessed through buttons at the top.

- **Student Count** – A count of students at a Building/District
 - **Grad/Dropout Rate** – Percentage of HS students graduated or dropped out in 4, 5, or 6 years
 - **Non-Resident Status** – School of Choice numbers (in and out) for the District
 - **Retained In Grade** – Count of students enrolled in the same grade for consecutive years
 - **Attendance** – Attendance rates for all students and chronically absent students
 - **Student Mobility** – Counts of students who have changed school within a school year
- **Special Education – Annual Public Reporting - SPP**
 - **Selected Indicator Reports** – Make your selection to compare District performance to State Performance on 14 indicators.

- **College Enrollment by High School** – Number of graduates who enrolled in a college

- **College Remedial Coursework** – The number of graduates who take at least one remedial course the year after graduation
- **College Progression by Graduating Class** – How your students are progressing in PS Education after graduation
- **Student Pathways Aggregate for H.S.** – A .pdf summary of all of the above reports in one document

- **Child Count** – A count of children enrolled in different PreK programs

- **Kindergarten Pathways** – The order in which children were enrolled in publicly-funded early childhood programs prior to entering kindergarten

Achievement Gap

- **Grades 3-8 Assessments** – M-STEP, MEAP, and MI-Access Proficiency and Scores Data
- **High School Assessments** – M-STEP, MME, and MI-Access Proficiency and Scores Data
- **College Readiness** – The percentage of students meeting the College Ready Benchmark on SAT/ACT
- **Student Growth** – Changes in student scores over time for students who have taken two or more consecutive state summative assessments
- **Students Not Tested** – An Excel download of students (statewide) not tested with reasons
- **Top 30/Bottom 30 Analysis** – Different subgroup breakdowns of students scoring in the top/bottom 30 percent (Not calculated for 2014-2015)
- **Achievement Gap (Logged in users only)** – Choose a comparison site and compare percent proficient in a specific assessment (Data not available for 2014-2015 M-STEP)
