Sinking Fund Election Coming!

On Tuesday, May 7, 2013, the Fennville Board of Education will ask voters to approve a 1/2-mill sinking fund request for the renovation and repair of district facilities, along with site and safety improvements.

By law, the proposed Building and Site Sinking Fund **cannot** be used for salaries, supplies, or equipment.

The ballot language reads:

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Fennville Public Schools, Allegan County, Michigan, be increased by and the board of education be authorized to levy not to exceed .5 mill (\$.50 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 10 years, 2013 to 2022, inclusive, to create a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2013 is approximately \$170,000?

Voting will be held at your township hall or city precinct polling place. If you will be out of town on the day of the election, are physically unable to attend the polls, or are 60 years of age or older, **you may vote by absentee ballot**. Absentee ballot applications are available from your local township or city clerk and must be submitted by Saturday, May 4, 2013.

The last day to register to vote is April 8, 2013.
