
- A Central Office **Enhancement** is valid only in Michigan

SUSTAIN EXCELLENCE

Year 1: Program Requirements | Time commitment: 10 days, 60 hours

NAVIGATE LEADERSHIP

HORIZON YEAR 2

Completing Year 1 and Year 2 earns attendees an Administrator Certificate with a Central Office Endorsement OR a Central Office Endorsement on a current Administrator Certificate.

Participants must complete Year 1 of Sustain Excellence or Navigate Leadership to be eligible for Horizon Year 2.

Time commitment: 5 days, 30 hours, with mentor coach support throughout the year

Course content will focus on:

- What researched strategies can provide guidance in strengthening district culture and improving the health of the organization?
- How do we expand Fact-Finding and data analysis to strengthen culture and improve the organization's health?
- What researched strategies can influence strategic action planning at the school or district level?
